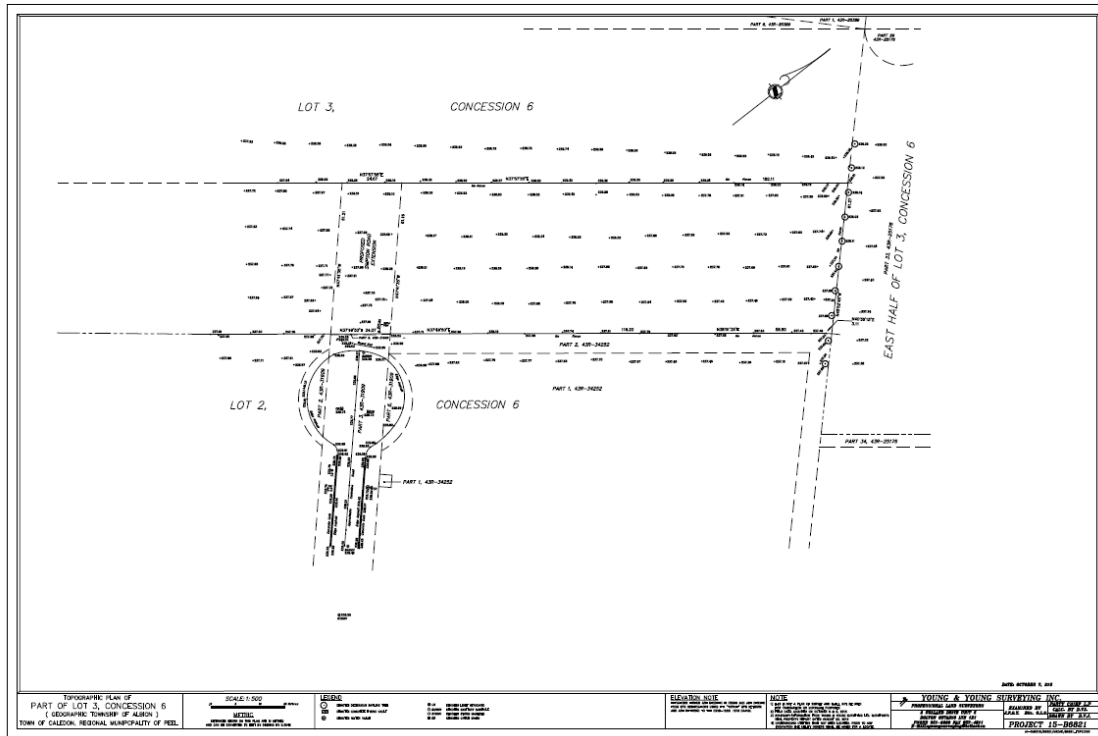

Background and Assignment
